Examiners will be appointed and mutually acceptable dates and venues arranged.

The question which the Examiners will ask themselves in assessing the overall ability of the candidate is:

CAN THIS PERSON TAKE SOLE CHARGE OF AN OPERATION UNDER VARIABLE WEATHER CONDITIONS AND REMAIN EFFECTIVE?

The Candidate's attention is drawn to the following pre-requisites required prior to being accepted for examination:

- 1. Be an Annual Flying Member of the BHPA
- 2. Must be aged 18 years or over
- 3. Hold Pilot rating (and environment) minimum in the relevant discipline
- General discipline experience. Have logged (solo) in the discipline 100 flying hours, or 250 launches, or 50 flights (PA Squares).
- 5. i) **Specific environment/discipline experience.** Have completed 40 launches in the envronment and discipline for which the Dual Licence is being sought.
 - ii) **Specific environment/discipline currency.** Have completed 20 launches in the preceding 12 months, in the environment and discipline for which the Dual Licence is being sought.
- 6. Produce a letter of support or recommendation from a Club Chairman, Senior Coach, or CFI.
- 7. Have logged on a dual glider: a minimum of 4 flights in passenger role and position; a minimum of 20 flights as pilot in command.
- 8. Must supply a licensed dual pilot as a passenger on the day of the examination.

The examination candidate will be required to demonstrate pilot proficiency, undertake a written exam paper, and an interview session with the examiner.
