### 1: CAA Tow Permit Renewal

As another towing season draws to a close it is already time to start planning for 2011 !

It is a BHPA requirement that any Pg or Hg towing operation \* inform the CAA (via the FSC Tow Panel) of the status of their site for the following season.

Please can officials from all relevant tow operations contact Russ Hicks via russ.hicks@bopenworld.com with the intended status of their tow sites for 2011. CAA permits are typically issued for up to five years so early notification of a site being lost or dispensed with is vital to maintain accuracy of air charts.

Failure to respond to this request will result in the automatic cancellation of a tow permit on 31st December 2010.

It may also be worthy of note that new applications can take up to 8 weeks to process (permanent or temporary). If you are planning an event in 2011 that requires a tow permit please submit the necessary application in plenty of time.
